Dwelling or Doubting Discoveries?

This past week, a massive discovery in the archaeological world was made in Jerusalem. An Israeli archaeologist said that artifacts found near the "Wailing Wall" (original wall of the temple), indicate that Jerusalem was the home of a strong and capable government in the 10th century B.C. If we mapped out the 10th century B.C on a timeline, this would be the period of Israelite Kings such as David and Solomon! But, many archaeologists, and even Biblical scholars, believe that David's monarchy was mythical. Other archaeologists question the accuracy of the discovery. They don't rule the discovery out, but they argue that the "truth was somewhere in the middle." Hopefully, this discovery will help more people believe in the authenticity and accuracy of God's holy word! Scripture certainly portrays David and Solomon living in 10th century B.C.!

However, even if it doesn't, I am quite confident in my faith, regardless of the archaeological discoveries found along the way which strengthen or weaken the historical details of scripture! After all, if our faith was formed by archaeological discoveries, we could never believe confidently! John tells us in John 20: 30, "**Jesus did many other miraculous signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book.**" Should we spend our entire lives looking for proof of these other signs? No, I think we should focus on what we have. John goes on to say, "**But these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ...**" (John 20:31)

To the world's credit, I guess we could say there are some "uncertainties" in the scripture! But to our credit, the "uncertainties" should not bother us! For we know that the same God who is "mysterious" and "supernatural", is the same God who knows every hair on our head, and the God who says, "**...And surely I am with you always, even to the end of the age.**" (Matthew 28:20)

So quit dwelling or doubting the discoveries! Rather, believe that the greatest discovery was your own, when you faithfully said, "**I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God!**"
