## The Worship and Work of the Church

Over the next few weeks we will be studying various aspects of the Church and God's people. We live in a time when religion and worship has become a sort of buffet. Whatever suits the individual is offered. I recently attended a funeral that was held at a "Cowboy Church" and saw that the focus was on the band and on accepting everyone the way they are. We do need to love... Christ does love us the way we are, but we must realize that we have to follow His commands and move toward him.

At the graveside, the preacher who performed the service stated that "...all churches are the same. They are like flavors of ice cream with a few nuts thrown in." I hear statements like this often. They are made to make men feel comfortable about the life they lead, and not cause any difficult choices in life. In Matthew 10: 32-40, Christ tells us that we must make a choice as to what is most important in life...comfort and family, or the God of creation.

In Ephesians 4, Paul tells the church in verse 4 through 6, "There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is above all and through all and in you all." When Paul speaks of "one faith," he refers to the one body of scripture that is to be followed. In order to be the church of Christ, we must follow that text and lead a life that magnifies Christ our Savior, the Holy Spirit that works in us, and the Father whose plan has brought us into existence.

As Christians, we must devote time to study and prayer if we want to know the true nature of worship. The lack of study and excitement is the cause of all this confusion. Hosea 4:6 states "my people are destroyed from lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also reject you as my priests; because you have ignored the law of your God, I also will ignore your children."

Starting today, make it your goal to study each week and grow in God's Word, so that we can KNOW (1 John 5:13) we serve him in the correct manner and with the right heart. We CAN be the church that Christ died for!!!
