God Created the Heavens and the Earth!

“In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.” This is one of the most debated statements among Bible believers and scientists. In an effort to show that the earth is old enough for evolution to exist, scientists keep pushing the age further and further into the past. All of this is an effort to deny a God that clearly exists. “His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made... (Romans 1:20)”

Yesterday I was reading a conversation on Facebook in which two people I grew up with were arguing about the time God took in His creation of the world. One of them stated that God accomplished all of the work of the creation week over millions of years, and it was only in the 1800’s that a preacher stated the days of creation were really days. I am in awe that even people who claim to be Christians are now taking up this belief. In my mind, to believe the creation week was literally 24 hour days is not a difficult thing. In Exodus 20:11 we see that the people of Israel were to keep the Sabbath on the seventh day “For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day.” They were to uphold the Sabbath as a day of rest in order to remember the literal day of rest that God took after creating the heavens and earth in six literal days. In view of the text, clearly Bible readers before the 1800’s considered the days to be literal.

I say all of this to show that the work of evolution is creeping into the Church. We are daily bombarded by the scientific data that tells us that there is no God, and we are caving in and compromising to make him fit. God existed before the beginning. He created the “science” that causes the universe to work. Science and scripture will go hand in hand when we clearly understand how both sides work. As God’s people, we must start by studying the Word. Then we can apply the works of science. When we start with scientific hypothesis and laws, and apply the Word to it, we can only end up confused...

Let’s study to find how God said He made the World!
